## 4. Amended Land Use Ordinance: Village Commercial District

Jon brings up separating rooftop solar from ground-mounted and to have rooftop solar to be revied by the Code Enforcement Officer.

Motion by Noel to approve an update to the decommissioning plan to include updated having the owner update the Town of the cost to decommission the solar energy system; to make

all roof-mounted solar energy systems to be approved by the Code Enforcement Officer; and to look at the direct impact for ground coverage standard.

Gwen identified that there is no need to amend the comprehensive plan.

Jon asks the Board to consider including Solar Energy Systems in the Rural Development 1 district as this district has the best possibility for future Solar development.

John asked about the scenic view?

Jon, we can exclude Solar from inside the scenic overlay zone. This will allow for a setback of 75 feet, and we can require landscaping to help hide the development.

Luke Muzzy offered comment on the solar amendment and to create more opportunities for other solar development.

Noel motion to accept the amendment as presented by Gwen and to include the Rural Develop 1 zoning district outside of the Scenic View Overlay zoning for Solar Energy Systems. Motion Passed: Yea 5, Nay 0
