Well it looks like spring is just around the corner, I know I'm ready for it.

That being said I want to be proactive enforcing the new Vendor's Ordinance and am asking for some assistance.

Specifically keeping vendors off the sidewalks, especially in the downtown area. Last year we had complaints of individuals setting up on the sidewalks causing a hazard to pedestrians. Lots of time they had to step into the street to avoid them! (We do have narrow sidewalks) Also we had several complaints of harassment which is totally unacceptable.

The Town of Greenville Vendor's Ordinance states, Sec 1, "Reasonable regulation on public and private property is necessary to protect public health, safety and welfare" and Sec 7c " No vendor shall create a public health and safety risk due to location, or unreasonably impede or inconvenience the public in a congested area. The judgment of a Police Officer or the CEO, exercised in good faith, shall be deemed conclusive as to whether the area is congested or the public impeded or inconvenienced."

I'm sure we all know the issue of last year and we really need to avoid the negative feedback.

So I would really appreciate any help so we can get the word out to customers and vendors before an issue arises
