Re: Ability to Serve – Map 22 Lot 58A Proposed Retail and Residential Building - Greenville

Dear Mr. Ewing,

The Maine Water Company (MWC) has received your request for an Ability to Serve Determination on behalf of your client, E. W. Littlefield, for the project located at the intersection of Lakeview St and Pritham Ave in Greenville, Maine and labeled as Tax Map 22 Lot 58A. The request indicates a proposed 4,663 sq ft building for 3 retail spaces. The additional space will add eleven sinks and 6 toilets for an estimated daily demand of 700 gallons per day. The static pressure in the area is approximately 90psi. Based on the criteria that has been presented, MWC does have sufficient capacity in the area from the existing 8-in cast iron public main on Pritham Ave to serve the needs of this project. Additional infrastructure improvements may be required at the expense of the developer to meet the overall needs of this project.

Conditions of Service

- Size and location of services will require further review by MWC.
- If fire protection services are required, a hydrant flow test at a nearby hydrant will be required at the expense of the developer to ensure adequate flows can be met in the event of a fire.
- Contact MWC to coordinate through any construction on waterworks infrastructure and to process paperwork or payments 3-4 weeks before construction.

Should the completion of this project not be executed within one year of the date of this letter, MWC reserves the right to reevaluate its ability to serve this project.

Water service will be provided in accordance with MWC Specifications, Terms and Conditions as well as Maine Public Utilities Commission rules. Please forward all design plan revisions as the project develops to prevent construction delays.
