1. Pledge of Allegiance: NOTED.

2. Opening of the Meeting & Declarations of Conflicts of Interest: The Chairperson will ask the members of the Select Board to review the meeting agenda and declare any potential conflicts of interests which members may have with the items listed. NOTHING BROUGHT FORTH.

3. Additions or Deletions to the Agenda: None

4. Set Tax Commitment (Mil Rate): Robbie spoke to say that between the quarterlies and the new construction this year that the valuation went up 500,000. He gave 3 scenarios for Select Board to look at. One with a mil rate of .0168 and an overlay of 154,282.12, second with a mil rate of .01675 and an overlay of 138,902.21 and the last of a mil rat of .0169 and an overlay of 185,041.97.

Marc Roy (the Town's Bookkeeper) spoke to the fact that the assigned Fund Balance was around 1.3 to 1.4 Million. The Revenues were up for 2020-2021 due to the fact that we got more revenues in State Revenue Sharing, Motor Vehicle Excise Tax, Boat Excise Tax and Revenue from Tree Growth Penalties. It was motioned by Richard Peat to accept the .01675 Mil Rate with the 138,902.21 overlay and seconded by Newt Pierce. Motion carried. 5-0. See attached Municipal Tax Rate Calculation Sheets.

5. Town Office Roof RFP: Approval 7 Award. Was decided to remove the Solar Panels by A.E. Robinson for around \$300-\$500. To cut, cap and drain. Motioned by Richard Peat and seconded by Ron Sarol. Motion carried 5-0. Was then decided to award JB Roofing. Motioned by Newton Pierce to Award JB Roofing with an amount of \$32,691.00 and seconded by Burton Whitman. Motion carried 5-0.
