1. Opening of the Meeting & Declaration of Conflicts of Interest: The Vice Chairman will ask the members of the Board of Selectmen to review the meeting agenda and declare any potential conflicts of interest which members may have with the items listed. Chairman was present at beginning of meeting, had to leave early. The Vice Chair presided over entire meeting. There were no potential conflicts of interests brought forth.

2. Minutes: Minutes from previous meetings were brought forth. Minutes from 4/17/19,4/24/19, 5/1/19, 5/20/19, 5/22/19, 5/31/19, 8/21/19, 9/4/19 and 10/2/19 were presented for approval. It was motioned by Janet Chasse and seconded by Newt Pierce to accept these minutes. Motion carried 5-0.

3. Additions or Deletions to the Agenda: No additions or deletions to meeting agenda.

4. Municipal Valuation Return- Board signatures. Municipal Valuation Return was brought forward for signatures. This had been previously reviewed and shared at prior meeting. The board signed the return. Copy to be included in minutes. Motion to sign by Bonnie DuBien and seconded by Newt Pierce to sign. Motion carried 5-0.

5. Managers' Report: Mike reports brush pile is gone. Mike also has checked with a company called Maine Logistics chipping solutions Company. They will come and chip for \$500.00 each time and take the chips as well. Mike states is costs us over \$6000.00 to remove current pile. Josh asked if there was a concern in holding chips? Mike states we have a limited holding area. Mike also states we would have to build a pad that would cost ~\$10,000.00. We are taking brush again. Janet believes we should charge for larger loads. Mike to evaluate in more detail and work on possible fee schedule.

Mike states Trash RFP's have been mailed out. A total of 5 have been sent. We will await the results.

Mike working on signage for transfer station. Received report on transfer station Mike will work through. we had not filed our reports since 2014.

We received 9 applicants for Town for the office position. Mike, Beth and or Rocky and a board member to do interviews.

CES will be coming in to work with folks on road plan tomorrow. Also had to reschedule downtown stakeholders meeting due to weather.

Mike brought forth the question of paper roads? He has been asked when does a paper road become a street? The boards understanding is that there is a series of standards and criteria that must be met before even considering. Must be brought forth to a town meeting for consideration and a vote? Mike to do a little more research on.

Mike states new truck is in service and ready to go.

6. Public Comment Period: Lurline Arco asks if the brush pile contained stumps and could be an issue?

7. What's on your mind? – Opportunity for Selectpersons to share questions, concerns, ideas or Suggestions. Informational only: Janet- asks if skateboard park equipment has been removed from playground? Mike stated it has. Geno-Nothing, Newt-Nothing. Josh asked about the steamplant.

8. Other Business: Josh asked John Contreni about the Trees planted in town under the canopy project grant. John said they have been planted, mulched and believes they did well. Hopefully will tolerate the Winter well.
