1. Pledge of Allegiance. Noted

2. Opening of the Meeting & Declaration of Conflicts of Interest: The Chairperson will ask the members of the Select Board to review the meeting agenda and declare any potential conflicts of interest which members may have with the items listed. Chair Bonnie explained to the board why we needed to have this special meeting. She explained that at our last meeting, business that was conducted was not official and the meeting could not be considered a valid meeting due to the fact that our new selectmen Richard Peat was not sworn in and all votes would be considered non-binding. This was an oversight and was validated by town clerk Roxanne Lizotte. Informational only.

3. Election of Select Board Chair: It was motioned by Janet Chasse and seconded by Richard Peat to elect Bonnie DuBien as board chair for this upcoming fiscal year. Motion carried 3-0-1 with Bonnie abstaining.

4. Election of Vice Chair: It was motioned by Richard Peat and seconded Bonnie DuBien to elect Geno Murray as Vice Chair of the board for upcoming fiscal year. Motion carried 3-0-1 with Murray abstaining. Janet questioned Richard Peat on why changed his mind on vice chair nomination since last meeting? Richard stated he really didn't think she wanted the position. Janet expressed her concerns displeasure on this nomination.

5. Discussion on creating full time Code Enforcement Officer Position and possible special town meeting. Mike presented his concerns in not be able to fill the shared CEO/Fire Chief position. He also shared he has real concerns around maintaining this combined position moving forward. Given the fact that there is many proposed projects and recent real estate sales; He feels CEO position should be full time. After considerable discussion it was motioned by Richard Peat and seconded by Geno Murray to move forward to a special town meeting to create a full time CEO position. Motion carried 3-1 with Janet Chasse in opposition.

6. Adjourn; There being no other business, it was motioned by Janet Chasse and seconded by Richard Peat to adjourn at 6:45 P.M. Motion carried 4-0.
