Town of Greenville Application for Public Rubbish Collection along Private (Camp) Road System

Purpose: This application is for rubbish collection service in camp road systems for qualified residents* to have rubbish collected and hauled away by the Town's rubbish collection contractor (currently Moosehead Rubbish). This application is meant to provide all of the requisite permissions from camp road owners, abutters and maintenance agents to allow this rubbish collection service to occur. It is the intention of the Town of Greenville to offer this service to those areas where public ways do not extend, and where until now, rubbish collection was not allowed.

*"Qualified resident" refers to those currently eligible for rubbish collection through the Town: seasonal or

year-round residents, but not businesses, visiting contractors, or owners of rental camps.

^{***&}quot;Public Way" refers to a Town way or State road or state-aid road (minor collector).

- (b) A letter from the Association stating its relationship to the road system in question (e.g., membership association of abutting landowners who pay dues for the purpose of cost-sharing summer and/or winter road maintenance), and designating an agent to speak for the Association. This letter must affirm that the Association has the authority to grant permission for the Town and its agent to travel over this road for the purposes of rubbish collection.
- (c) A letter of agreement between the Association's agent and the Town of Greenville's current Rubbish Collection Contractor giving permission for this service to be provided, as well as agreement that each party will hold the other harmless for any damages (example letter attached).

After the Town of Greenville receives this completed application and it is processed, the Town Manager, who may consult with both the Road Association Agent and/or the Town's Rubbish Collection Contractor, will make a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen for approval to expand the Town's Rubbish Collection Service to said private road (camp road) system, and under what terms and conditions are advisable.

The Board of Selectmen will act to approve or not approve the application, with or without conditions, after which both the Private (Camp) Road Association's Agent and the Town's Rubbish Collection Contractor will receive notification in writing from the Town Manager of the Board of Selectmen's decision, including the start date for the service, any seasonal end date, or conditions. If approved, this agreement will become an addendum to the Town's contract for rubbish collection services.

Letter of Agreement between Rubbish Collection Company and Road Association

I agree to notify both the Town Manager and the Agent for the Road Association whenever such road or weather conditions result in these services being curtailed.
