2. **Minutes:** It was motioned by Janet Chasse and seconded by Newt Pierce to accept minutes of the January 15, 2020 meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
3. **Additions or Deletions to the Agenda:** Added 4a for Grace Bardsley, Program Director for the D.M.O.
4. **John Contreni-Report on Main Street America Meeting:** John spoke on a meeting he attended in Skowhegan of Building Downtown Networks that Foster Entrepreneurship and Innovation. He spoke on the different learning experiences of businesses and the learning process that each went through. He also spoke on the Service Providers for different businesses.  - 4a. **Grace Bardsley: Program Director for D.M.O.:** She spoke on a grant that Jennie Ward (AMC) is working on for another new badge the Pinnacle Pursuit. The grant is for \$7,000. The volunteers working on the badge would be mainly doing trail clearing. Grace is asking the Town be the agent to receive the money and to distribute it those in need. Attached is the Pinnacle Pursuit brochure that they would be revamping and ordering with the \$7,000. After discussion motion made by Janet to be the agent for the Grant and seconded by Newt. Motion carried 3-0.
5. **Katie Luce (Purpleville) (Alzheimer's)** Katie is asking the board to support a weeklong event not just a weekend this year. The week being June 26-July 3, 2020, the week just before the 4th of July. She has a few new events and all the events from last year. Last year her goal was \$5,000 and they raised \$13,885!! The appointments are made on a yearly basis for the State of Maine. Motion made by Janet to accept and sign appointments and seconded by Newt. Motion carried 3-0.
