3. Minutes: June 3 2020 accepted with the exception of a correction on #11 Executive Session.

4. Additions or Deletions to the Agenda: Police Chief, James Carr was added to 4A. Motion by Janet and Newt to add Jim to agenda. 4-0

4a. Jim Carr, Police Chief spoke on:

5. Signed abatement for Chamberlain for past 3 years for \$198.51. Motion by Janet seconded by Newt to accept. Motion carried. 4-0.

6. Signed a supplemental for Roger Rowe property on East Rd. Property taken out of tree growth. Motion by Janet seconded by Newt to accept. Motion carried. 4-0.

7. Signed 2 Liquor licenses: One for Lodge and Moosehead and one for Rod N' Reel. Motion by Janet seconded by Newt to accept. Motion carried. 4-0.

8. Lengthy discussion on changing name of Thoreau Park. David Slagger spoke in favor of changing name. Board not inclined to change name at this time. Maybe find a new place to put Henry Red Eagle. Board to think on it and come back to it. Talk to Suzanne Auclair possibly.
9. Manager's Report: Working on LED lights with CMP, probably going to happen in Fall: working on 3 lots at transfer station, may need to get ahold on DEP and wet lands: Land next to beach looking at cost. 2 police resumes received: Fire/Code enforcement reposted: New Library Director will bring her in to introduce her to board. Fire works in progress, mowing done. Matt St. Laurent asking to have Fire Dept welcome guests to Town with a Fire Boot to collect money as there will be no Fly-in this year to raise money. Approve 4-0 by Board. ATV access from Scammon to Highland Ave discussed. DOT given approval if the Board is ok with it.

Public Comments: Discussion on ATV access from Scammon to Highland Ave. Was stated that it was approved from intersection to Family Campground on Moosehead Lake Road, No up Pleasant St. and Lily Bay Road. Bonnie stated DOT will not approve if the Select Board is not ok with it. Robert Beaumier said that he had a letter from a prior Town Manager giving them permission to go ahead. Board wants a copy of the letter. Newt spoke that he was at the same meeting and yes they voted yes to Moosehead Lake Road and No to the other two.
